#### PALM SUNDAY REFLECTION - STABAT MATER

The Sorrowful Mother was standing in tears beside the Cross as her Son was hanging

Her soul was full of grief and anguish and sorrow, for a sword pierced [it].

How sad and how afflicted was that blessed One, the Mother of an only Son!

How she grieved and lamented, the faithful Mother as she saw the pangs of her glorious Son.

Who is there who would not weep, were he to see Christ's Mother in such great torment?

Who could not feel compassion when thinking of Christ's Mother sorrowing with her Son?

For the sins of her own people she saw Jesus in agony and broken by the scourging.

She saw the dear One born of her all the time He was dying and abandoned Until He gave up the ghost.

Come then Mother, you fount of love, my grasping the intensity of [your] sorrow grant, that I may mourn with you.

Make my heart burn with love for Christ, [my] God, that I may find grace before Him.

O holy Mother, this achieve: impress the wounds of the Crucified One

deep in my very heart.

Of your wounded Begotten One,
for He deigned to suffer so much for me,
Let me share with you the pangs.

Grant me to weep lovingly with you; to feel the pains of the Crucified One as long as I live.

That I might not burn and be consumed in the flames, be a defence to me, O Virgin, on judgement day.

O Christ, when I must depart hence, give me through the Mother to seize the palm of victory.

When my body is dead, grant that my soul be given the glory of paradise. Amen.
