SUNDAY REFLECTION

John the Baptist is a perennially challenging and important figure in salvation history. Luke's opening verse situates John's call in a universal context that includes some of the very men – powerful political and religious leaders – who are threatened by and opposed to both John and Jesus. In this unique context marked by Roman occupation and socio-economic injustice, the word of God comes to John: a prophet who prepares the way for God's impending intervention in human history.

The renewal that John proclaims has broad-ranging personal but also social implications. His Baptism of repentance is meant to be an outward sign of metanoia or conversion, a radical transformation – grounded in the experience of God's love and forgiveness – that in the experience in commitment to the common good.

As Christians, we naturally associate the new and definitive liberation from sin and suffering that John proclaims with the life, death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. John's message – his call to repentance in the face of immanent judgement – would have been disturbing back then, but perhaps we need to hear it even more today. His ministry challenges us this Advent season to recall and embrace the radical nature of our baptismal calling to repent and believe in the Good News – to witness to and prepare the way for the renewal of all creation that we associate with Christ's return.

BAMBINELLI SUNDAY

Bambinelli Sunday is an event that takes place in Rome on the third Sunday of Advent each year, and will be taking place here at St Joseph Parish after all Masses on **Sunday December 15**, 2025. The idea

is to encourage everyone to bring their 'Bambinelli' to be blessed on the third Sunday of Advent, Gaudete Sunday. This blessing of the Christ Child is a way to help children focus on the real and true meaning of Christmas, the birth of Jesus. We also suggest that each family take the 'Bambinelli' home after the blessing, place it in a special box and then wrap that box. On Christmas morning, before you open presents, place Jesus in the manger.

"SIMBANG GABI" AT ST. JOSEPH...

This Christmas tradition is coming to St. Joseph Parish once again, and will be celebrated starting Sunday, December 15th during the 12:00pm mass up to Monday, December 23rd. Other masses designated for this novena are; Monday, December 16th at 7:00pm, Tuesday December 17th at 7:00pm, Thursday December 19th at 7pm, Saturday, December 21st at 5:00pm, Sunday December 12noon and Monday, December 23rd at 7:00

pm. The traditional Christmas custom of "Simbang Gabi" in the Philippines, is a devotional 9-day novena (series of masses), practiced by Roman Catholics in anticipation and preparation for the birth of our Lord Jesus Christ, and to honour our Blessed Mother. "Simbang Gabi" is not just an old custom that is celebrated because we want to, but rather it is a way of asking "favor or blessings" from the Lord, as it is believed that if one completes the whole series of nine masses, prayers and/or intentions will be granted. There will be breaking of bread and fellowship at the church hall following each Simbang Gabi masses. Everyone is welcome to join this 9-day mass novena/celebration at St. Joseph's to experience an old but popular Filipino tradition. Hope you can join us.

On the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception, Monday, December 9 this year, the Blessed Sacrament will be exposed for Adoration at the Basilica following Morning Prayer at 8:30am, until Vespers and Benediction at 6:15pm. The Solemn Mass of the Immaculate Conception will be celebrated at 7:00pm. As the Diocese's Shrine of the Blessed Virgin Mary, a Plenary Indulgence is granted, under the usual conditions, for any of the faithful who make a pilgrimage to the Basilica of Our Lady Immaculate on the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception.
